Spotless Cleaning Environmental Policy

Spotless Cleaning recognises that all cleaning activity and the day-to-day running of the business has an impact on the environment. In an effort to safeguard the environment for future generations, the business attempts to minimise its impact both locally and further afield, by considering all activity undertaken by staff, as well as the materials and services offered by suppliers.

Wherever possible, all employees will strive to make choices that take the environment into consideration. The company will continually review and improve such measures as technology and the environment evolves.

Such measures include:

- Checking the sustainability and source of all cleaning fluids and chemicals (bulk of chemicals provided by a British manufacturer named Clover Chemicals with awards for environmentally friendly products)
- Using domestic suppliers where possible reducing the carbon footprint of international imports
- Considering the sustainability and environmental policies of all suppliers
- Encouraging the use of alternatives to paper products
- Encouraging the use of reusable products as opposed to disposable ones, such as disposable wipes or cloths
- Using concentrated chemicals to minimise the consumption of packaging and the impact of transporting chemicals
- Recycling all used packaging and containers after use
- Using fewer suppliers to deliver as many goods as possible to site in less trips
- Condensing orders for materials to reduce the number of deliveries required
- Utilising technology to share all information digitally and minimise the use of paper and printers
- Encouraging staff to car share wherever possible
- Where the purchase of paper products is necessary, ensuring that they are sourced from sustainable, well managed forests
